## CALL FOR PAPERS

Dear Colleagues,

We are pleased to invite you to the third edition of the **Translaton** international conference, which forms part of a series of translation-studies conferences that address a broad range of issues related to translation.

The conference will take place on **24–25 September 2026** at the Institute of Specialised and Intercultural Communication at the Faculty of Applied Linguistics, the University of Warsaw. The upcoming edition will revolve around the following theme: **Translating Transformations. Transforming Translations.**

The main aim of this conference series is to create a platform that brings together various – often contrasting, yet invariably complementary – scientific perspectives on translation reality, different research methodologies, and applications of research tools. Likewise, it offers a valuable opportunity to exchange insights regarding the practical aspects of professional translation and interpreting. Such a broad thematic scope not only fosters scholarly discourse in translation studies and contributes to its development, but it also refines the conceptual basis for translation training, competence models and methodological approaches.

We cordially invite you to submit a paper proposal within the following research areas:

- Translation studies – the present and the future;
- Empirical research in translation studies;
- Translation and interpreting – diverse perspectives and paradigms;
- Audiovisual translation (AVT: subtitles, voice-over, dubbing, accessibility);
- Intersemiotic and intermedial translation;
- Literary translation in its social context;
- Specialised translation and translation of LSP texts;
- *Plain language* as intralinguistic translation;
- Translation training and didactics in schools and higher education;
- Translation quality, translation praxeology, especially in the era of machine translation (MT);
- Post-editing (PE), genAI and other emerging translation technologies;
- Translation market and translation practices;
- Translation in the era of the new media: website, software and video game localisation;
- Neurobiological and psychological aspects of translation processes;
- Semi-professional translation practices (*crowdsourcing, fandubbing, etc.*).

## Participation details:

Conference languages: English, German, Polish.

Venue: the conference will be held at the Faculty of Applied Linguistics, University of Warsaw (ul. Dobra 55, 00-312 Warszawa/ Warsaw, Poland).

Willing participants will have the opportunity to submit their conference papers for publication in *Kwartalnik Neofilologiczny* and *Studia Translatorica*, both scored academic journals.

## Abstract submission deadline: 30<sup>th</sup> April 2026.

Registration without presentation until 30<sup>th</sup> June 2026.

The conference fee of 550 PLN / 130 EUR covers attendance at all conference sessions and the conference dinner.

Students and PhD candidates are entitled to a reduced fee of 275 PLN / 65 EUR.
